Housing Assignment Process Update: Monthly Randomization

- New for 2023-2024: Housing assignments are no longer firstcome, first-served.
- Students who apply between the first and last day of a given month will be randomized together to be assigned their room selection number (spot in line).
- January applicants receive their room selection numbers first, followed by February applicants, and groups for March, April, and May 1.

Why the change?

- Realistic Expectations: Managing the expectations of more than 3,000 applicants on opening day is complicated.
- Technology limitations: Our housing management system has limits on the number of concurrent users.
- Decreasing anxiety: We regularly hear "this is so stressful" from prospective students and families.
- Equal access for all: Hawkeyes have varied internet access, and bandwidth should not impact students' ability to live on campus.
- Helping Hawkeyes across the globe: Hawkeyes come from varying time zones, and not everyone is on Hawkeye time, yet.
- Supporting senior year: Hawkeyes are involved in a variety of activities that limit their availability to apply at a specific date/time.
