

# Tiered Violence Prevention Education

Fraternity and Sorority Life and the Violence Prevention Team collaborated to redesign the structure of the prevention education program for members of Greek organizations on campus. The restructuring resulted in a new multidose curriculum that builds on itself as students progress. The new program has also moved from being chapter-based to individual-based. All councils are engaged in the new tiered prevention education.

Every member of an FSL organization is required to attend one facilitated, interactive workshop each year of their membership. Workshops are designed to scale and build upon previous education.

First Year	Enthusiastic Consent	In your own words, how would you define consent?
Second Year	Bystander Intervention for Preventing Sexual Violence	How would you intervene? If you would not intervene, share why.
Third Year	Bystander Intervention, Healthy Relationships, or Dismantling Rape Culture	Describe two healthy behaviors in a relationship.
Fourth Year	Bystander Intervention, Healthy Relationships, or Dismantling Rape Culture	List two ways rape culture is perpetuated.
