

What is lowa **GROW**°?


lowa GROW® (Guided Reflection on Work) is a program designed to help students connect their classroom learning with their on-the-job experiences. Through structured conversations between student employees and supervisors, lowa GROW® encourages students to reflect on how their work and academic experiences are related.

Enhancing Student Success

lowa **GROW**® helps students see the relevance of their classroom learning in the workplace, which can boost both their job performance and their academic experience.

Supervisors play a critical role in helping students reflect on their learning. Even brief check-ins that ask students to relate their work experience to coursework can strengthen these connections.

Key Elements of Iowa GROW°

Structured Conversations

Supervisors should have conversations with student employees guided by four key questions:

- 1 How is this job fitting in with your academics?
- 2 What are you learning here that's helping you in school?
- 3 What are you learning in class that you can apply here at work?
- 4 Can you give me examples of things you've learned here that you'll use in your career?

Students participating in Iowa GROW® are more likely to report campus employment helped them build upon essential skills employers are looking for, including:

- Communication skills
- Time management
- Critical thinking and problem solving

Supervisors should have lowa **GROW**® conversations with student employees **two times per semester**. These conversations can be held in a one-on-one setting or among a group of student employees.
