2017 STUDENT EMPLOYEE SURVEY SUMMARY

WHAT IS THIS? The Division of Student Life administers the Student Employee Survey every spring semester to measure the outcomes of Iowa GROW[®]. The most current data is outlined here.

The Division of Student Life Student Employee Survey was conducted spring, 2017. The survey link was sent to 1880 students and 714 responses were received (38% response rate).
