## Overview

Undergraduate Research Fellowships provide a research experience for undergraduate students and assist staff in the Division in conducting research projects in support of student success. There were five research projects and five fellows in fall 2022.



## Fall 2022 Projects

Well-being within eSports opportunities on campus; Hazing prevention within student organizations; Connection between green spaces and student well-being; Student feedback on gender-based violence prevention and response resources; and Equitable naming policy for programs, awards, and facilities
